# HEMISPHERIC CIVIL SOCIETY AND SOCIAL ACTORS FORUM

The following information will assist you on your preparations for the activities that will be held with civil society and social actors on the occasion of the VII Summit of the Americas.

# **VENUE AND DATES OF THE ACTIVITIES**

The Hemispheric Forum of Civil Society and Social Actors will take place in the Centro de Convenciones Vasco Núñez de Balboa at the Hotel El Panamá on April 8-9 and the morning of April 10, 2015.

The Dialogue with the Heads of State and Government Representatives of participating countries in the VII Summit of the Americas will also take place in the Centro de Convenciones Vasco Núñez de Balboa at Hotel El Panamá in the afternoon of April 10, 2015.

The meeting rooms will be distributed with the objective of facilitating the work:

- The plenary sessions of the Forum will take place in the Centro de Convenciones Vasco Núñez de Balboa at the Hotel El Panamá.
- The meetings of the Thematic Working Groups will be held in the Diamante, Topacio, Rubí,
   Zafiro, Bella Vista and Bellamar rooms at the Hotel El Panamá.

## **ACCREDITATION**

Once participants receive the confirmation from Panama regarding their participation, they must fill out the online Accreditation Form available at: <a href="https://panama.formstack.com/forms/foros">https://panama.formstack.com/forms/foros</a>. To access this form, an exclusive access code will be issued.

To get the accreditation at the venue, participants must show an official identification.

Accreditations for civil society and social actors approved to participate in the Forum and Dialogue will be handed out on Monday, April 6, 2015, Tuesday, April 7, 2015 from 8:30am to 6:00pm and the morning of April 8, 2015 from 8:30am to 12:00pm at the Hotel El Panamá.

Starting on April 8, 2015, participants will have to show their accreditation in order to access the Hotel El Panamá.

## **ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS**

Participants to the Hemispheric Forum of Civil Society and Social Actors are expected to arrive on April 6-7, 2015 at the Tocumen International Airport.

Upon their arrival, it is recommended to follow the signs with the logo of the VII Summit of the Americas to the special lanes to expedite the process.

We suggest identifying the luggage with tags of the VII Summit of the Americas logo for faster recognition.

Buses will be located outside the airport to transport participants to their selected hotels from the list of suggested hotels. Those buses will indicate the route they will take.

# TECHNICAL SECRETARIAT AND PARTICIPANT'S LOUNGE

A Technical Secretariat will be installed at the Esmeralda room to support the needs of the Organizing Committee which will be provided with the necessary office and communications equipment.

A Participant's Lounge will also be installed at the Coral room, which will include computers and printers as well as internet service to facilitate the work.

# **WORKING LANGUAGES**

English and Spanish interpretation will be available for the Plenary Sessions of the Forum and in the four OAS official languages for the Dialogue.

## **ROOM ATTENDANTS**

Room Attendants will be available in the meeting rooms to guide the participants inside the hotel and to answer questions that could arise during the work and regarding their stay in Panama.

24-hour emergency health services will be available at the Hotel El Panamá.

## WEATHER

The weather in Panamá is pleasantly tropical. The country has two seasons: rainy and dry. The rainy season goes from May to December, with sporadic rains that allow for the warm sunlight to peek through during most part of the day. During the dry season, also called "summer" - from mid-December to April - nice winds blow permanently.

Forecasted weather conditions in Panama for the period of the VII Summit of the Americas are as follows:

•	Average minimum temperature	74.12°F
•	Average relative humidity	83%
•	Average temperature	76.1°F

Every purchase in Panama includes a 7% Personal Property Transfer Tax (ITBM), except for medicine, food and school supplies.

Some restaurants include the tip in the bill. It is customary to leave a tip of 10% of total consumption.

For international commercial flights, the airport tax is included in the cost of the flight ticket.
